COVID Safety Plan & Procedure for Framingham Parks & Recreation Swim Lessons & Lifeguard Training

Current Plan: September 2021

In addition to any/all State, Local, and CDC Guidance, the following will be implemented;

SWIM LESSONS & LIFEGUARD TRAINING

GENERAL GUIDANCE

- Swimmers will enter the pool from Door # 13
- Locker Rooms will NOT be available
- Maximum of 30 people will be allowed on pool deck and in pool per hour
- Masks must be worn onto and off of the pool deck
- Masks must be removed prior to entering the pool
- Lesson Instructors, in the pool, will wear face shields
- Lesson Instructors, on the deck, will have the choice to wear face shields or face masks
- 1 parent per family allowed in stands
- Parents must social distance and wear masks
- Parents may not come onto pool deck
- Swimmers will meet parents in stands at the end of their lesson
- Swimmers and Parents will exit the facility through Door # 12

LESSON FLOW

- Swimmers will arrive wearing appropriate bathing attire & enter the pool deck from the door located in the back hallway (door #13)
 - o Parent will meet lesson instructor at pool deck door, drop off swimmer, walk up ramp, and enter the pool from the main hallway. Parents must remain in the stands. Masks will be mandatory. Parents will be asked to keep 6' socially distanced while observing.
- At the end of their session, swimmers will be asked to meet their parent in the stands, put their mask on, and exit the facility through the main hallway (door #12)
- Parents will keep swimmers bags/towels in the stands
- Masks will be required anytime a swimmer is not in the water
- When entering & exiting the pool, students will do so 1 person at a time
- All shared equipment (ie. kickboards, weighted brick, tubes, backboard) will be sanitized after each class
- Students in Lifeguard Training may bring their bag/towel onto the deck and space them 6ft apart
- Students will utilize the entire pool to ensure distancing while in the water
